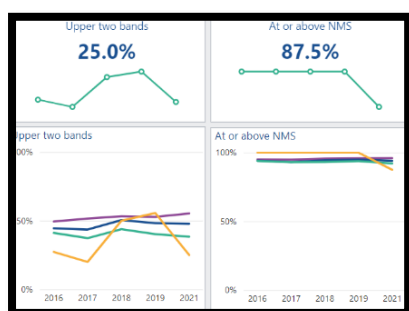
1. Enable the purchase of a teacher aide to work with reading groups on a Tuesday – Friday morning. (AIP strategy 1)

Our initiatives include

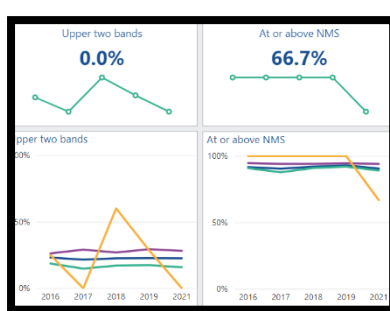
1. The Curriculum Implementation focus of 2022 Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) has a focus on:
 - The Teaching of Modelled Reading
 - Consolidation of the school's Literacy Framework which includes the foci of reading, writing and spelling)

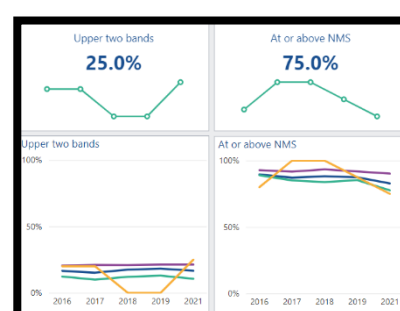

2. The Evidence Based Pedagogical Practices focus of 2022 AIP has a focus on:
 - Moderation underpinning systemic curriculum delivery
 - Effective pedagogical practices in K-10 curriculum areas (including age appropriate pedagogies)
 - Development of assessment literate teachers

Target: Inconsistency in maintaining teachers at a small regional school, and the need for consistent school wide processes to be informed, owned by staff, documented and used. Building an expert teaching team through professional development, work shadowing and development of assessment literate teachers.

3. In line with the School Opinion Survey data and the wellbeing survey, aligned to the Student Learning and Wellbeing Framework, to engage and motivate secondary students to becoming global citizens.
